Title of the paper 18 pt., capital letters, bold, centered. Under the title shall be pass the authors (name and surname), 14 pt., capital letters, bold, centered. Prof. Dr. Branislav Antala, Phd is a professor at Comenius University, Faculty of Physical education and Sports in Bratislava, Slovakia. He is also Visiting professor in Faculty of Kinesiology, University of Zagreb, Croatia. His area of specialization is Sport pedagogy, Evaluation in physical education and Sport management. He has been author of about 160 original scientific articles and reports published in 20 countries and 5 edited books. He delivered 18 invited keynote lectures and about 30 presentations in international conferences. He is a Member of the Editorial Boards of 14 international journals (Gymnasium (Romania), Kinesiology (Croatia), Sport Logia (Bosnia and Herzegovina), Graduate Journal of Sport Exercise & Physical Education Research (Great Britain) Asian Journal of Exercise and Sports Science (Hong-Kong) etc.).

Prof. Dr. Branislav Antala, PhD is a recipient of many international awards for contribution on development of PE in the world (FIEP Gold Cross; Medalha Sylvio Raso; Águila de Oro; Pico Bolivar Award, Diploma of Excellency etc.).
